Through a yearlong fund-raising campaign, St. Barnabas Charities in 2008 alone enabled poor and low-income (Medicaid) patients to receive free care totaling more than \$4.3 million at St. Barnabas Nursing Home, Valencia Woods at St. Barnabas and The Arbors at St. Barnabas.

St. Barnabas Health System is the largest health care concern of its kind in Pennsylvania and is composed of St. Barnabas Charities, the Kean Theatre, St. Barnabas Medical Center, St. Barnabas Nursing Home, The Washington Place at St. Barnabas, The Village at St. Barnabas, The Woodlands at St. Barnabas, Valencia Woods at St. Barnabas and The Arbors at St. Barnabas. Founded in 1900, St. Barnabas Health System is faith-based yet non-denominational, non-profit and charitable.
